

# Transbaikalia. Atsay II



## Description

The Atsay cemetery is located in Selenginskiy district of Buryatia, on the northern coast of the lake Gusinoe. It was discovered by an archaeological expedition in 1927 near the Atsayskiy datsan. Then, the cemetery was partially excavated by a joint archaeological squad of the Buryat Institute of Social Sciences of the BF SB USSR AS and Irkutsk State University named after Zhdanov A. A. The site dates from Bronze Age.

## Transbaikalia. Atsay II. Bunch of beads



### Description

A bunch of beads (10 pcs). The outer side is well-polished. The items are small and barrel-shaped.

Seven beads are made of carnelian, one is made of pink jasper, one is made of turquoise, and one is probably made of ceramic.

Shaping on hard abrasives, grinding, drilling
